Dear Parents/Carers and Students,

There will be two sport choices for all Year 7 students in Term 1. Students may choose to participate in the Swim & Survive program to be conducted at Scully Park Pool or they may elect to travel to Riverside each Wednesday afternoon to participate in a variety of sports including soccer, oztag, cricket, touch, ultimate frisbee and softball.

The Department of Education and Communities has specific guidelines which must be adhered to as outlined in the Department Policy: *Guidelines for the Safe Conduct of Sport and Physical Activity in School*. These guidelines state that students who are participating in an out of school sport are to catch a bus to and from the venue. Students are not allowed to make their own way to Sport due to *Occupational Health & Safety Policies* and *Duty of Care*.

The following information outlines the requirements of all students during Sport at Peel High School:

- Students will have their attendance recorded at the beginning of sport and again at the end of sport.
- Continued fractional truancy will result in a pre-suspension and the normal discipline policy will be followed.
- Students are required to wear the correct sports uniform.
- Some sports may be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, with alternate activities and travel arrangements put in place.
- Any student requiring an epi pen or insulin must see a Deputy Principal/nominated person for a medical pass before going on a bus. Students who don't receive a medical pass will not be permitted to leave the school grounds and will attend sport at school.
