

## Peer Conflict Flow Chart

Student, parent/carer or teacher makes a report about peer conflict. If peer conflict occurs in the classroom, teacher involved needs to address the issue in the first instance with detentions and/or levels.

Step 1) Year advisors investigate/meeting with student. Complete peer conflict discussion card if appropriate at this stage

Behaviour continues and is reported again

Step 2) Peer conflict discussion card must be completed by YA and filled in including offering student access to the school counsellor. Record on Sentral and contract placed in YA folder.

Behaviour reported again

Step 3) Year Advisor gives peer conflict contract to HT Welfare

HT welfare has meeting with student, parents/carers (where appropriate)

AEO's and counsellor may also be involved in this meeting at this stage

Behaviour is reported again involving the same student

Step 4) HT Welfare gives DP peer conflict contract and meeting minutes from HT intervention stage

DP conducts student interview and possibly issues a pre-suspension letter

Behaviour reported again

Step 5) DP follows suspension policy as per DEC guidelines
